
Hanford Summary

Three Components

- River Corridor
- Central Plateau
- Tank Waste

Two DOE Offices

- Richland Operations Office
- Office of River Protection



Workforce/Economics

- **9,305 total DOE and contractor employees**
- **Hanford Budget is approximately \$2.3 billion per year**
- **Continued need for cleanup at current funding levels for the foreseeable future**
- **Cleanup mission continues to 2050 - 2060**
- **Richland Operations Office, the Office River Protection, and our prime contractors reported \$660 million of small business awards in fiscal year 2015 (\$366M –ORP & \$294M – RL)**
- **Outlook for fiscal year 2016 small business awards will be similar**

DOE Office of River Protection Mission

To safeguard the nuclear waste stored in Hanford's 177 underground tanks and to manage the waste safely and responsibly until it can be treated in the Waste Treatment and Immobilization Plant for final disposition



The ORP Team

Office of River Protection (ORP)

ORP is responsible for planning, integrating, and managing the River Protection Program executed by contractors performing work under ORP overall management. ORP has 215 employees, both federal and contractor.

Washington River Protection Solutions (WRPS)

WRPS is the prime contractor responsible for safely managing and operating the Tank Farms. WRPS has 1,800 employees*.

Bechtel National, Inc. (BNI)

BNI is responsible for the engineering and construction of the Waste Treatment Plant. BNI has 2,653 employees*.

Wastren Advantage, Inc. (WAI)


WAI is the prime contractor responsible for managing the 222-S Laboratory.

Protect the workers, public and environment by further risk reduction, provide necessary infrastructure for continued safe and effective cleanup operations, and restore Hanford lands for access and use

The RL Team

Richland Operations Office (RL)

RL is responsible for environmental cleanup including restoring the Columbia River Corridor, transitioning the Central Plateau of the Hanford Site for waste treatment and long-term storage, and putting DOE's assets to work solving regional and global environmental problems. RL has approx. 310 employees, both federal and federal contractor support.

CH2M Hill Plateau Remediation Company (CHPRC)

CHPRC is the prime contractor responsible for the safe, environmental cleanup of the Central Plateau at the Hanford Site. CHPRC has approx. 1,400 employees*.

HPM Corporation (HPMC)

HPMC is responsible for the occupational medical services to the Department of Energy and to Hanford Site employees. HPMC has approx. 80 employees*.

Mission Support Alliance (MSA)

MSA is the prime contractor responsible for the integrated infrastructure services at the Hanford Site. MSA has approx. 1,900 employees*.

Washington Closure Hanford (WCH)

WCH is the prime contractor responsible for environmental remediation on Hanford's River Corridor. WCH has approx. 340 employees*.
