Attached is the Annual National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) Planning Summary for the NNSA Production Office, which consists of Pantex Plant and Y-12 Plant. The summary contains the status of ongoing NEPA Compliance Activities: Environmental Assessments (EA's) expected to be required in the next 12 months; Environmental Impact Statements (EIS's) expected to be required in the next 24 months; and the status of ongoing EA's. Our 3-year evaluation has determined that the site-wide environmental impact statements for both Pantex and Y-12 are adequate to facilitate future NEPA compliance efforts.
