SUBJECT: Recent DOE Directives Changes


SUMMARY: On September 1, 2009, the Department of Energy (DOE) manuals were revised and issued to correspond with the following recent Contractor Requirements Documents (CRDs) changes to the following Directives:

- DOE M 205.1-8 Administrative Change 1—Cyber Security Incident Management Manual;
- DOE M 205.1-7 Administrative Change 1—Security Controls for Unclassified Information Systems Manual;
- DOE M 205.1-6 Administrative Change 1—Media Sanitization Manual;
- DOE M 205.1-5 Administrative Change 1—Cyber Security Process Requirements Manual

Under the Department's Directives Program (DOE Order 251.1C), Heads of Field Elements are responsible for determining which contracts are to include the CRD. Contracting Officers, once notified, are responsible for incorporating the CRD into affected contracts. If the Heads of Field Element's determination has not yet been provided, Contracting Officers should request the determination of which, if any, contracts are affected and remind them that they may sign up for automated notification at www.directives.doe.gov.
