SUBJECT: DOE O 442.2 Differing Professional Opinions for Technical Issues Involving
Environment, Safety and Health
DOE O 470.4B Safeguards and Security Program
DOE O 472.2 Personnel Security

SUMMARY: The Department issued Contractor Requirements Documents (CRDs) for the subject Directives as follows: DOE O 442.2 (July 29, 2011), DOE O 470.4B (July 21, 2011) and DOE O 472.2 (July 27, 2011).

Under the Department's Directives Program (DOE Order 251.1C), Heads of Field Elements are generally responsible for determining which contracts are to include the CRD. Contracting Officers, once notified, are responsible for incorporating the CRD into affected contracts. Since some Heads of Field Elements may not be aware that this change has been issued, Contracting Officers should request their determination of which, if any, contracts are affected and remind them that they may sign up for automated notification at www.directives.doe.gov.
