SUBJECT: Federal Acquisition Circular 2005-62

SUMMARY: Attached for your information is a list and summary of FAR amendments published in the November 20, 2012 *Federal Register* at 77 FR 69714.

If you are issuing any acquisitions for supplies and/or services on behalf of the Department of Defense (DoD) that are not authorized under DOE's Work for Others Program (see DEAR 970.1707 for guidance); then carefully read interim rule item II Interagency Acquisitions: Compliance by Nondefense Agencies with Defense Procurement Requirements. (FAR Case 2012-010). It was effective November 20, 2012.

If DOE or NNSA will issue any acquisitions for supplies and/or services on behalf of DoD that are not authorized under DOE's Work for Others (WFO) Program, MA-60 and NNSA Senior Procurement Executives (SPE) will prepare certification that DOE/NNSA will comply with defense procurement requirements for fiscal year 2013 – see FAR 17.703(a). To help assess whether or not the SPEs need compliance certification, let the point of contact in this policy flash know if you will issue or have issued

acquisitions for supplies and/or services on behalf of DOD that are not under DOE's WFO program.
