American Recovery and Reinvestment Act Payments Surge Past \$4 Billion

FINANCIAL HIGHLIGHTS

- **More than \$4 BILLION** in Recovery Act payments are accelerating environmental cleanup
- **67%** of EM Recovery Act funds have been **paid**

Financial data are based on reporting as of March 9, 2011, and are subject to change.

EM has made more than \$4 billion in Recovery Act payments, or 32 percent of the DOE's \$12.4 billion in Recovery Act payments. DOE received \$35.2 billion from the Recovery Act, and EM's portion of that was \$6 billion, or 17 percent.

JOB HIGHLIGHTS

- According to FederalReporting.gov, a government-wide data collection system, EM Recovery Act sites reported a total of **9,362** full-time equivalent (FTE) employees between **October and December 2010**.
- Also, EM collects a cumulative number of workers — which now is **29,923** — that represents all workers who have benefited from Recovery Act funding since the start of the program in early 2009. That figure includes part-time, temporary, and full-time workers.
