The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) has issued a Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) based on completion of an Environmental Assessment (EA) that analyzes the potential environmental impacts associated with the:

Cuyahoga County Agricultural Society is proposing to use American Reinvestment and Recovery Act funds from DOE for the purchase and installation of a single 660 kW wind turbine. County funds will be used for the construction of an educational energy center at the Fairground's complex in Berea, OH. DOE's Golden Field Office has determined that providing funding to Cuyahoga County for the proposed project would not constitute a major Federal action significantly affecting the quality of the human environment within the meaning of the National Environmental Policy Act.
